



5. Allotment rent invoices have been sent out.
6. Letters to tenants with uncultivated plots have also been sent out.
7. Concerns raised from a tenant at Sandyfield Allotments re a missing padlock from the main gate. The padlock has now been returned.
8. Several street lights reported as not working to SSE.
9. There has been a water leak which runs under/across Dichfield Common. Thames Water are dealing with this.
10. As agreed at the previous meeting, I have asked the contractor to repair and paint the bench on Cadmore End Common.
11. I have been contacted by a concerned resident re an overgrown hedge onto the footpath. The hedge adjoins a property owned by Red Kite. Red Kite are communicating with the owner.
12. The Parish Council continues to be copied to emails from concerned residents re helicopter noise.
13. Works have started to repair the fence adjoining land at Lane End Playing Fields.
14. I sent a letter of support from the Parish Council re the re-opening of the Old Ship Inn, Cadmore End.
15. The planning comments as agreed at the last PC meeting were submitted.
16. Copied to an email to Red Kite and Steve Baker re the playground and litter (off Simmons Way).
17. As agreed I have asked Buckland Landscapes to clear the foliage around the top pond.
18. All Councillor DPI's have been sent to Buckinghamshire Council and also listed on the PC's website.
19. No further feedback received from residents of Chalky Field re the proposed development or the hedge.
20. The order for the new lantern at Clinkard Place has been sent to SSE.
21. As agreed at the last meeting I have written to Buckinghamshire Council and expressed the PC's support towards the extension of the licence for Strawberry Grove to use Harris Garden as a small seating area.

**7) Spend Priorities Status**

Cllr Harries reported that assuming the sale of the Chalky Field site goes ahead, Council has set up a small steering group to establish spend priorities. A new children's play area continued to be a top priority. The steering group intend to publish a paper for Councillors at the November meeting regarding spend priorities and how best to communicate with residents.

**8) Finance - Approval of the account for September 2021**

Council approved the expenditure of £19,544.48. Council noted the income was £83,305.50. Council noted the current account closing balance of £185,666.63 as of 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

**9) Platinum Jubilee initial thoughts**

An extended bank holiday, from Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2022, will provide an opportunity for communities and people throughout the United Kingdom to come together to celebrate this historic milestone.

The Parish Council discussed several options :

- a. Provide seed money for street parties, For example £100 for the first 50 streets to apply.

- b. Tree planting, possibly one in each of the five "Ends" the parish with a commemorative plaque.
- c. Celebration mugs to be given to all the children at Lane End Primary School and Cadmore End School.
- d. A beacon.

Councillors were asked to email the Clerk their suggestions/thoughts before the next meeting for further discussion.

**10) To consider purchasing and installing an AED/Defibrillator in Cadmore End**

The Parish Council considered purchasing and installing a defibrillator at Cadmore End Village Hall. The approximate cost would be £2850.00 plus installation. Council unanimously agreed to purchase and install a new defibrillator.

**11) To consider drafting a Sustainable Environmental Statement**

Cllr Graham volunteered to draft a Sustainable Environmental Statement for Council to consider at a future meeting. Council thanked Cllr Graham for volunteering for this.

**12) Allotments**

Parish Councillors visited the Sandyfields and Bunkers allotment sites prior to the meeting. It was noted that there are some unused and overgrown plots. Cllrs Wright, Harries and Stewart are meeting next week to discuss options.

**13) Matters raised by Councillors**

Cllr Detsiny reported re Airpark /Helicopter noise. The recent JCC meeting wasn't satisfactory. A small working group of Lane End and Frieth Parish Councillors together with WAPAG representatives has been formed to better engage with Airpark management
